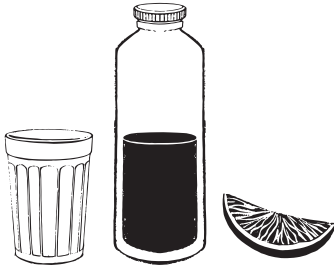

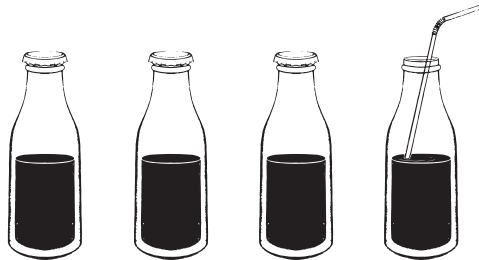

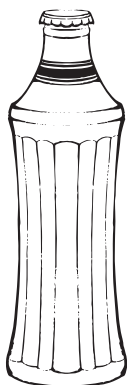

At Kindred, we champion what we believe a cocktail should be; delicious, well-crafted and thoughtfully sourced. Each of our cocktails tells a London story, using spirits that may have been distilled within walking distance, or from further afield but whose makers work hard to give back to their local community.



Signature Cocktails

Blackberry Spritz 13

Our latest house spritz doesn't cut any corners in terms of deliciousness nor quintessential English ingredients. The faint bitterness from wild harvested and organic **gooseberry**, **rhubarb** and **chuckleberry** is found using **Sipello Bittersweet Aperitif** and offset by **Bristol Syrup Company's blackberry shrub**, **sparkling wine** and **London Essence Company's pink grapefruit soda**.



The Social Drifter 11.5

Our twist on a French 75: we're using **Two Drifters carbon-neutral rum** from Devon, a 'Social Elixir' from **Three Spirit** which infuses **cacao** and the "ancient aphrodisiac" **damiana**. Zestiness is provided by **Bristol Syrup Company's lime sherbet**, and the drink is crowned with **sparkling wine**.



Whiskey & Honey Sour, I Suppose 14.5

A collaboration between the Cooney family beekeepers and the Boann Distillery, **The Whistler Irish whiskey Honey Liqueur** provides the base of our latest sour, of sorts. Shaken up with fresh **lemon**, **Bristol Syrup Company's warming ginger syrup**, **Angostura bitters** and the undefinable 'Plum, I Suppose' from **Empirical Spirits**: a nutty spirit distilled from **plum kernels** and **marigold**.



West 6 Win'd Up 12

Our latest take on our delightfully frothy bestseller uses the delicious **Discarded Grape Skin vodka**: a fruity zero-waste **vodka** sustainably distilled from pomace. Shaken up with **passion fruit**, **Bonanto aperitivo**, **pineapple** and **lime**.

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Street Market Daiquiri 11.5

Celebrating the hustle, bustle and diversity of West London's famous markets, we are vigorously shaking **Chairman's Spiced rum** from St. Lucia, **watermelon, elderflower, pineapple** and **fresh lime juice** for this tropical zinger.



Over the Hills 13.5

An incredibly complex vodka highball using a three-grain **Ukrainian vodka** from our friend **Dima**. We have floral notes from the **cherry blossom in Everleaf Mountain** aperitivo and our **elderflower cordial**, citrus from fresh **lime** and **Pierre Ferrand's limited edition yuzu curaçao**, a dry nuttiness from Gonzalèz Byass' **Tio Pepe sherry**, and a healthy spritz of one of our all-time favourite sodas: **London Essence Company peach & jasmine soda**.



Quiet Rebel Martini 12

Our take on the legendary Pornstar Martini incorporates **Nc'nean B Corp-certified organic single malt whisky**. The tropical and vanilla-led notes of this cutting-edge Scotch lend itself well to the **passion fruit** and **vanilla** counterparts found in the drink, alongside a little lick of **Aperol** for a hint of **grapefruit**. Served with a side of **sparkling wine** and **passion fruit bubbles**.



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Rum Punches

We're proud to be part of West London's rich & diverse history, and for us, nothing quite represents the area as well as the mighty rum punch. We have concocted three; all inspired by distinctive and historical punches that have been served to Londoners from the early 19th Century to the present day.

Banana Bread Punch 13.5

We've got a delicious new fruity and long punch to join our mainstays. Named after freedom fighter Olaudah Equiano, **Equiano rum** has grabbed our attention not only by contributing to equality projects, but also with a delicious blend of Mauritian and Bajan rums aged in Cognac and American oak casks respectively. With hints of **butterscotch**, **ginger** and **vanilla**, this fantastic rum lends itself very well to a French liqueur made from **Brazilian bananas** and a splash of **Cognac**, **fresh lime** and **pineapple** and a touch of **Angostura bitters**. Tastes like it sounds: delicious!



Regency Rhubarb Punch 9.5

A delicious blend of Devon's **Two Drifters overproof spiced pineapple rum**, **cachaça** from Capucana, **spiced rhubarb liqueur**, **dry cherry liqueur** and **pineapple syrup** balanced with **lime acid** and **Mao Feng green tea**. For a modern take on a vintage punch.



Treacle Punch 9.5

An apple-laced rum Old Fashioned with both bite and punch. **Skipper Demerara rum**, **Chairman's Reserve Spiced rum**, and the incredibly funky **Funk Drop overproof rum** from **England's Drop Works distillery**, spiked with **Angostura bitters** and **acid-adjusted clear apple juice** served on the rocks.



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Twisted classics

Our take on a few of our favourites. Should you fancy a less twisted classic – just ask! We have spent years perfecting and fine-tuning our house versions, using the same ‘ingredients with integrity’ that we use for all our house created concoctions.

Rudy Cosmo 13

One of the greatest twists on the Cosmopolitan is the ‘Rude Cosmo’. As agave spirits have seen the biggest growth globally, we now understand that there is nothing ‘rude’ about agave spirits, much less the flagship tequila coming from the family-owned legendary La Altea Distillery. But with a tip of the checkered porkpie hat to our ska legends, we are naming this twist after the rude boys that ran the London scene from the late ‘60s to the ‘80s. Our **aged tequila** is shaken with fresh **cranberry, lemon, yuzu, watermelon syrup** and **pineapple bitters**; a tropically fruit-driven message to you.



Estes Margarita 14



A tribute to our dearly departed friend - the Tequila Ambassador: who loved eating pink grapefruit every morning; naturally enjoyed all things agave but started off as a wine connoisseur; and brought margaritas to Europe even before limes were commonly available. An almost sangria-like twist on a Tommy's, we shake his **Curado Blue Agave tequila** with **fresh pink grapefruit** and **lemon, organic agave syrup** and float a little of our lively and **fruity Bobal red wine** on top.

Peace Martini 14

Over a century ago the oldest publicly owned Japanese Garden was created right here, in Hammersmith Park: the Garden of Peace. To commemorate this, we have created our ultimate Martini based on Japanese ingredients: **Ukiyo Tokyo dry gin, umeshu plum wine, yuzu dry curaçao**, and **shrub**, with a couple of drops of **soy sauce** for added umami.



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Better than Pimm's 12.5

We've updated everybody's favourite summer drink which features **East London Liquor Company Kew Gardens Collaboration Gin** that uses **Douglas fir, fragrant lavender** and **orange** from the gardens themselves. We are backing this up with **Mouse Kingdom's new strawberry liqueur** –from Manchester – a white vermouth from **El Bandarra** and some **cucumber bitters**, lengthened with **London Essence Company's lemonade**.
Not Pimm's, but perhaps better than?



Tiger Mezcalita 13.5

For agave lovers searching for their next favourite take on a Margarita, look no further. **Smoky Ojo de Tigre mezcal** shaken with a **chilli liqueur, ginger** and **lime**, and served with our salty '**secret spice mix**' rim. Rawr!

Bramble Crumble 12.5

London's very own Dick Bradsell's Bramble remains a steadfast modern classic and a drink of our times. Inspired by pricking his fingers on bramble bushes whilst hunting for blackberries, we're coupling **Bristolian blackberry shrub** with **lemon, Miracle Foamer, lemon juice** and a yummy **apple and hibiscus gin** distilled by the crew at **East London's 58 & Co.** Served short, shaken and punchy.



Walnut Old Fashioned 13

Our latest and greatest take on an Old Fashioned is inspired by the British retro-classic confectionary, the Walnut Whip. Using **Nomad Single Malt** - an Irish whiskey that finishes its ageing in oloroso sherry barrels in Spain that give the whiskey hints of nuts, ginger and dark chocolate – we stir up with **vanilla, chocolate bitters** and a touch of **green walnut liqueur** from the Provence. Served with **chocolate covered coffee beans**.

Cocktails Without Alcohol

Lively Spritz 9.6

Three Spirits' invigorating 'Livener' elixir – using **guayusa**, **guava leaf** and energising **schisandra berry** – deftly combined with **Genie's** ethically sourced, **crisp apple kombucha**, served with **cucumber slices**.



Cherry Collins 9.6

Sustainably sourced botanicals such as **orange blossom** and **saffron** from **Everleaf Forest** are paired with the **Bristol Syrup Company's** juicy **black cherry and vanilla syrup**, built tall with a touch of fresh lemon and a spritz of **London Essence Company's** peach and jasmine soda.



Deep Dark Wood 9.6

Our award-winning alcohol-free 'spirit' – **Three Spirit Nightcap** – evokes a nighttime walk in the woods. We have paired the dominant notes of **valerian**, **ashwagandha**, **white willow bark** and **lemon balm** with a wonderful **Bristolian blackberry shrub**, locally pressed **apple juice** and a **grapefruit and rosemary tonic** from the **London Essence Company**.

for you to tuck into.**



West London Gins

Not so much riding the crest of the modern-day gin boom but practically creating it, West London has secured itself as a hotspot for brands that have paved the way for the renaissance.

As early as 1999 **Martin Miller** – the West London based iconoclastic and eccentric entrepreneur, antique collector and general party starter – decided to create his very own gin. Gin-thusiasts will agree that his **Westbourne Strength** is his opus, named after his residence in Westbourne Grove.

Hot on his heels, ten years later **Sipsmith** literally changed an archaic London-based law by petitioning for the right to use a smaller ‘craft’ still – named Prudence - to make their wonderful new gin on Naysmith Street in Hammersmith. Since then, the brand has proved to be a benchmark for the international gin community.

Over in East London we’ve selected a couple of our favourites: **58 & Co’s** award-winning B Corp distiller produces an **Apple & Hibiscus Pink Gin** using ‘wonky apples’ from Loddington Farm in Kent. You’ll be able to find this wonderful fruity gin in our **Bramble Crumble cocktail**, using a sprightly blackberry shrub made by **The Bristol Syrup Company**.

We’re also serving **East London’s Liqueur Company’s Kew Gin** that sources excess Douglas fir, lavender and orange from the iconic West London gardens. This we pair with a new strawberry liqueur produced under the railway arches in Manchester by the **Mouse Kingdom Liqueurs**, white vermouth and cucumber bitters for a complex interpretation of the Pimm’s serve.

Further afield we’ve got some intriguing gins such as **Boatyard’s Old Tom** gin from Ireland’s first B Corp distillery, all the way to a fragrant gin made in Japan: **Ukiyo’s Tokyo Dry Gin** is made from redistilled rice spirit that perfectly informs our umami-laced **Peace Martini**.

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The Rum Revolution

Rum is experiencing a full-blown renaissance. Mainstays remain: what is a West London bar without the iconic **Wray & Nephew Overproof** on the backbar? Or from the same Jamaican distillery, our award-winning favourite: **Appleton 12 Year Old Rare Casks**, that is equally magnificent sipped neat or in our signature house **Mai Tai**. Or indeed Bajan classic fruit-driven **Doorly's 3 Year Old White Rum**, which we use in our house daiquiri.

More recently we've added the multi award winning **Equiano** rum; a rum named after freedom fighter - Olaudah Equiano – who liberated himself by selling rum. To commemorate this the brand give proceeds to ground level freedom and equality projects. It also happens to be the world's first African and Caribbean rum blend, and you'll find it in our long and fruity **Banana Bread Punch**.

Interestingly we have also noticed an uptick of rum made in England, so our proud to support these homegrown brands. **Two Drifters**, a carbon negative rum made down in Devon by a husband and wife team can be found in our twist on a French 75, **The Social Drifter** paired with a **Social Elixir from the Three Spirits**, and our collection of the innovative and funky **Drop Works rums** from Nottinghamshire you'll find spiking some of our short punches.

International laws and regulations mean that not all of our spirits can be produced in London. That said, we strive to bring you liquids from around the world that have tenable link to London and the U.K.

Paul Hayes created the excellent and multi-award-winning **Vivir tequila** in 2019 specifically to address the need for a benchmark for English-funded tequila brands. We stock his **blanco** and also use his **El Sueño Silver** as our house pour. Try it in our house Margarita, or request it spicy with our own blend of raspberry spice mix, using a touch of chef’s Aleppo pepper.

In 1982 the legendary global tequila ambassador Tomas Estes introduced Mexican food and culture to Britain. Before this, there

was nowhere in London where you might stumble upon a decent **Margarita** or taco, let alone a **Paloma**.

Covent Garden’s Cafe Pacifico remains a stalwart tequila temple, and whilst our friend has sadly passed, his legacy remains intact – if only partially through the tequila brands he has created with his family and the legendary Camarena family, who are consistently recognised as the best tequila distillers in the world.

Their groundbreaking **Curado** range, can be found in our tribute drink the **Estes Margarita** (now our founder Anna’s favourite ever cocktail), and our watermelon-laced **Rudy Cosmo** features their iconic **Tapatio Añejo** tequila.

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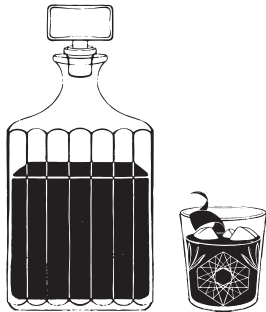
